THORNBURY PICKLEBALL COURTS TO BE LOCATED AT TOMAHAWK RECREATION COMPLEX

Thornbury ON, August 25, 2020 — At its meeting yesterday, the Town of the Blue Mountains' Council passed a motion to locate the previously approved outdoor pickleball courts to the Tomahawk Recreation Complex instead of Bayview Park. The spokesperson for Friends of Bayview Park, Jayne Sutherland, released the following statement:
